❖ Clinical Trials: Strategies to Innovate EmeRgENcy Care Clinical Trials Network (SIREN) – Network. SIREN will enable conduct of high-quality, multi-site clinical trials to improve the outcomes for patients with neurologic, cardiac, respiratory, and hematologic, and trauma emergency events. SIREN will consist of one Clinical Coordinating Center (CCC), one Data Coordinating Center (DCC) and up to 10 clinical centers (Hubs). Orlando Regional Medical Center is one of the clinical centers (HUBS) that will be leading a network of hospitals in Florida called the Florida Alliance for Research in Emergency Medicine (FLARE-EM) NIH CLINICAL RESEARCH NETWORK GRANT.
