

Financial Assistance Program

Need help paying your bill? In an effort to meet the community's healthcare needs, financial assistance is available to patients/guarantors who have limited or no resources to pay for emergent or medically necessary services rendered at an Orlando Health facility.

Applying for financial assistance

- You may apply for assistance before, during or after your hospital stay by visiting with Financial Counselors who are available at Orlando Health Business Office locations at each of our facilities
- Representatives from hospital and physician billing are available Monday – Friday, 8:30 am – 4:30 pm and can be reached by phone or by email (FinancialAssistance@orlandohealth.com)

Supporting documents

All required documentation is necessary to process your application. It may include but is not limited to the following:

- Guarantor Financial Statement Application (GFSA) and if necessary, the most recent federal tax returns
- Patients can access the GFSA in English, Spanish, French Creole and Portuguese free of charge at an Orlando Health Business Office location or on the Orlando Health website: OrlandoHealth.com/FinancialHelp

Qualifying for financial assistance

- Orlando Health will evaluate the patient's/ guarantor's ability to pay and offer assistance to those who qualify
- Assistance will be determined by evaluating your annual household income and family size with respect to the Federal Poverty Level
- If determined eligible, emergent or medically necessary services will be provided free of charge.

- **Can I see my bill using Quick Pay?**
No, you cannot see your bill with Quick Pay. The security of your information is very important to us. To be able to view your bill, you will need to create a login at OrlandoHealthBiz.com.
- **Can I pay my physician bills too?**
Yes, if the physician is employed by Orlando Health.
- **Can I stop paper statements from coming in the mail?**
Yes, when you sign into OrlandoHealthBiz.com you can choose if you would like your appointment reminders, letters or statements delivered electronically or by mail.
