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Checklist of Materials

The following is a checklist of materials that will assist your neuropsychologist in your assessment. Please secure as much of this information as possible, and bring it with you to your first scheduled appointment.

- 1. Please bring neurology consultation notes from any neurologist other than your referring physician. We will receive records from the referring physician before your appointment.
- 2. Written report (**NOT** films, etc.) of any brain MRI and CT scans, EEGs or lumbar punctures **UNRELATED** to your current injury (i.e., prior stroke or head injury) or that were done anywhere other than Orlando Health.
- 3. Treatment summaries of any mental health services you have had (e.g., psychiatry, counseling, psychiatric hospitalization). You should have your provider release this information directly to the doctor that will be seeing you.
- Written report of any prior neuropsychological, psychological, or psychoeducational assessments. You should have your provider release this information directly to the doctor that will be seeing you.

If possible, the following records may be helpful:

Job Records: (if working or planning on returning to work)

- · Written job description provided by your employer
- Performance evaluations
- Resume

Please bring copies of any history you are providing that we may keep for our records.

Also, if you need to cancel or reschedule your appointment, please contact our office 24 business hours before your appointment. Please be advised if this is not done, a \$75 fee may be assessed.
