⦿ When to go to Express Care Walk-in Urgent Care Center

⦿ When to go to an Emergency Room

If you have a serious condition – stroke, heart attack, severe bleeding, head injury or other major trauma – go straight to the nearest Emergency Room. Don't take a chance with a life-threatening condition. The Emergency Room is the best place for these and other critical conditions, including:

- Abdominal pain
- Chest pain
- Difficulty breathing
- Large or deep open wounds
- Loss of consciousness
- Major burns
- Severe bleeding
- Severe head injury
- Spinal injuries
- Sudden loss of vision or blurred vision
- Sudden weakness
