Current Initiatives

Projects related to patient experience in process include the whiteboards, collaborative rounds, and discharge planning. The whiteboards are in the process of being updated and a collaborative group including the PFAC meets regularly on improving its content and design. Collaborative rounds which include a multidisciplinary team rounding on patients will refocus due to changes in team members. The corporate discharge project focuses on improving the process on day of discharge. Physicians are also receiving training on how to interact thoughtfully with patients from the patient's perspective through the course The Language of Caring-Communication Essentials for Patient Centered Care. This training was a collaboration between Dr. Rodier, Christina McGuirk, Bibi Alley, and Anthony Morales.

Opportunities and Actions Taken

An opportunity was identified regarding the delivery of patient meals.

Action Taken: Team Members now go the extra step and ask patients if more assistance is needed with their meal (opening, unwrapping, etc.) before leaving the room.

There is inconsistency in whiteboard completion among nursing units.

Action Taken: This information was shared with the Directors on each unit to ensure consistency in updating patient white boards and including the patient in their plan of care.

PFAC members also ensure that the clinical teams are actively involved in the patient's care by conducting bedside shift change report, updating the white boards, and conducting hourly purposeful rounding.
