Academic Scholarship for Underrepresented Minorities

The Orlando Health General Surgery Residency Program is committed to fostering diversity across the Orlando Health surgical workforce. We are interested in continuing to recruit residents from diverse backgrounds. As a residency program, we are pleased to offer a travel scholarship for underrepresented minority visiting students. This rotation elective is specifically designed for fourth-year medical students who are interested in pursuing a residency in general surgery. The scholarship is for up to \$500.00 in reimbursement for travel and housing during the 4-week elective.

Clerkship participants will be immersed in all aspects of the general surgery residency. Rotating medical students will participate in our academic conferences, inpatient care, outpatient clinical environment, and operative intervention. In addition, the opportunity to take overnight trauma call at our Level 1 Trauma Center is available. Rotating medical students will be able to choose what service line they would like to rotate through. Currently, rotational options include trauma and emergency general surgery, surgical critical care, pediatric surgery, vascular surgery, and surgical oncology. All these rotation options are located at our main Orlando health campus.

Eligibility requirements:

1. Fourth-year medical students in good standing at an accredited US medical screening
2. Considered and underrepresented minority in medicine
3. US citizen or permanent resident
